The program recognizes and rewards businesses for exceeding environmental protection requirements. Surface Systems has continuously demonstrated a strong record in environmental management and exceeds regulatory compliance for waste recycling and reductions in air and water pollution.

Surface Systems also received the Perfect Record award from the National Safety Council for surpassing five million hours worked without a lost-time injury. "Achieving this recognition from the National Safety Council is the culmination of years dedicated to the focused efforts needed to successfully integrate safety and health management systems into the business," said Bob O'Brien, manager, Safety and Health at the Moorestown facility.
