

Lockheed Martin In Partnership With Upper Merion Township Opens Road To Alleviate Route 202 Congestion

Lockheed Martin Management & Data Systems Completes Final Phase of \$30 Million Revitalization of Headquarters

Motorists traveling in the King of Prussia area have a new route option today following the opening of Goddard Road, a once-private road donated to Upper Merion Township by Lockheed Martin Management and Data Systems (M&DS).

The opening of Goddard Boulevard will allow motorists to bypass the often congested Route 202 to access the Lockheed Martin campus, King of Prussia Mall and other area businesses. Lockheed Martin representatives joined township and state officials for a grand opening ceremony today cutting a ribbon to mark the road's official opening. The opening of Goddard Boulevard culminates a six-year \$30 million expansion project of M&DS' headquarters in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania.

"I am proud that our company had the opportunity to partner with local, state, and federal officials and the private sector to develop and execute this project," said M&DS president Marc Hansen. "As one of the largest employers in King of Prussia, it was vital for our company to improve this site, and enhance the surrounding infrastructure to accommodate the unprecedented growth that our business has experienced over the last six years."

When the project began in 1996, M&DS \$1 billion company committed to the recapitalization of building 100, former location of General Electric Aerospace and Martin Marietta Astro Space, to house its new headquarters. M&DS converted and upgraded the building from a manufacturing to a high-tech facility, at a cost of \$30 million to provide a convenient and first-class working environment for its employees. Six years later, M&DS has grown to a \$1.8 billion company with approximately 3000 employees in the King of Prussia area.

"I'd like to compliment and thank Lockheed Martin for their cooperation with Upper Merion Township and the township's Transportation Authority in the completion of this project," stated Dan Rooney, chairman of the Upper Merion Board of Supervisors. "M&DS has fulfilled its commitment to our community and together we have demonstrated that private industry, in partnership with local government, can achieve extraordinary results."

Goddard Boulevard is approximately 6/10 of a mile long connecting North Gulph Road and Mall Boulevard with direct access to the Pennsylvania Turnpike, the Schuylkill Expressway East bound, Route 202 South and Route 422 East and West.
