The segment's principal businesses are located in Baltimore, MD; Eagan, MN; Moorestown, NJ; Syracuse, NY; and Manassas, VA.

Coutts, executive vice president of the Systems Integration business area. During a 24-year career in the U.S. Navy, Moosally held command positions aboard a guided missile destroyer and a battleship and served as the Navy's Deputy Chief of Legislative Affairs before retiring in 1990 with the rank of Captain. He is a graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy and received a master's degree in finance from Central Michigan University.
