

Journal Picks Lockheed Martin/Simon & Schuster As Semifinalist For Outsourcing Award

An innovative and nimble information technology outsourcing arrangement between New York publishing firm Simon & Schuster and Lockheed Martin has been recognized as one of 30 semifinalist pairings in Outsourcing Journal's Annual Editor's 2003 Choice Awards Program.

In the nomination for the award, Simon and Schuster CIO Anne Mander credited "an environment between our two companies that rewards innovation at every level, and encourages creative thinking. This has saved us both money and time."

Winners will be announced at a special awards dinner held in conjunction with the Sourcing Interests Group conference in May and will be featured in the May 15 issue of Outsourcing Journal and a May 26 special supplement in Forbes Magazine.
