The CMMI(R) product suite was developed to integrate multiple capability maturity models into a single improvement framework for use by organizations pursuing enterprisewide process improvement.

"By applying our world-class processes to the US101 helicopter program, we will ensure a low risk path to achieving an initial operational capability in 2007 for the new presidential helicopter,' said Meyer.
