He has several publications to his credit, two patents, and 18 peer, management, and external awards. Mendenhall holds a bachelor's degree in philosophy from St. Joseph's University and a master's degree in computer science from the University of Pennsylvania.

"The Lockheed Martin Fellows program demonstrates the Corporation's recognition that technology excellence is central to its success," Mendenhall said. "I'm happy that our work at the Advanced Technology Laboratories has contributed to that excellence."
