

# Congressional Medal Of Honor Foundation Names Lockheed Martin President And CEO Robert J. Stevens To Board Of Directors

Robert J. Stevens, President and CEO of Lockheed Martin Corporation, has been elected to the Congressional Medal of Honor Foundation board of directors. The Congressional Medal of Honor Foundation is a nonprofit organization whose purpose is to perpetuate the Medal of Honor's legacy of courage, sacrifice, and patriotism. The Medal of Honor is the nation's highest military award for valor in combat; there are presently 129 living recipients.

He serves on the International Advisory Board of the British-American Business Council, and on the Executive Committee of the Aerospace Industries Association. He is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations, and is Presiding Director of the Monsanto Company. During 2001 and 2002, Mr. Stevens also served on President Bush's Commission to Examine the Future of the United States Aerospace Industry.

Headquartered in Bethesda, Md., Lockheed Martin employs about 130,000 people worldwide and is principally engaged in the research, design, development, manufacture and integration of advanced technology systems, products and services. The corporation reported 2003 sales of \$31.8 billion.
