As part of the initial partnership agreement, since 1999, Kelly has served as a public-private teaming partner with OC-ALC, repairing TF39 and T56 engines under the largest competitively won maintenance contract ever awarded by the U.S. Air Force.

Located in San Antonio, Texas, Kelly Aviation Center, L.P. is a joint venture between Lockheed Martin, GE - Aviation and Rolls-Royce.
