Lockheed Martin together with TRICARE Management Activity (TMA) and the Military Health System (MHS) are celebrating a significant milestone of one billion TRICARE Encounter Data (TED) healthcare records processed. TMA serves as the national headquarters responsible for administering a worldwide medical benefits program for the Department of Defense.

Lockheed Martin has supported the development and implementation of the capability to process and convert TED records since before their inception, having provided technical data-mart, application and consultant support to TMA TEDS operations for the past 10 years.
