## Gettysburg Begins Celebration For 2013 Congressional Medal Of Honor Society Convention

Also in recognition of the upcoming Convention, localGettysburg-area school districts are implementing the Congressional Medal of Honor Foundation's Character Development Program, which incorporates the ideals of courage and selfless service into middle and high school curricula to build character and promote responsible citizenship.

"It's important to educate students and the community regarding the values the Medal of Honor embodies - courage, sacrifice and selfless service," Monahan said. "Through the upcoming Convention and the accompanying events, we hope to increase awareness about the Medal of Honor and what it represents."

Robert J. Stevens, Chairman and CEO of Lockheed Martin will serve as the 2013 Convention Chairman. Lockheed Martin is a major sponsor of this year's event along with Boeing, BAE Systems, UTC, Northrop Grumman, Raytheon, Xylem, Exelis, ITT and Rockwell Collins.
