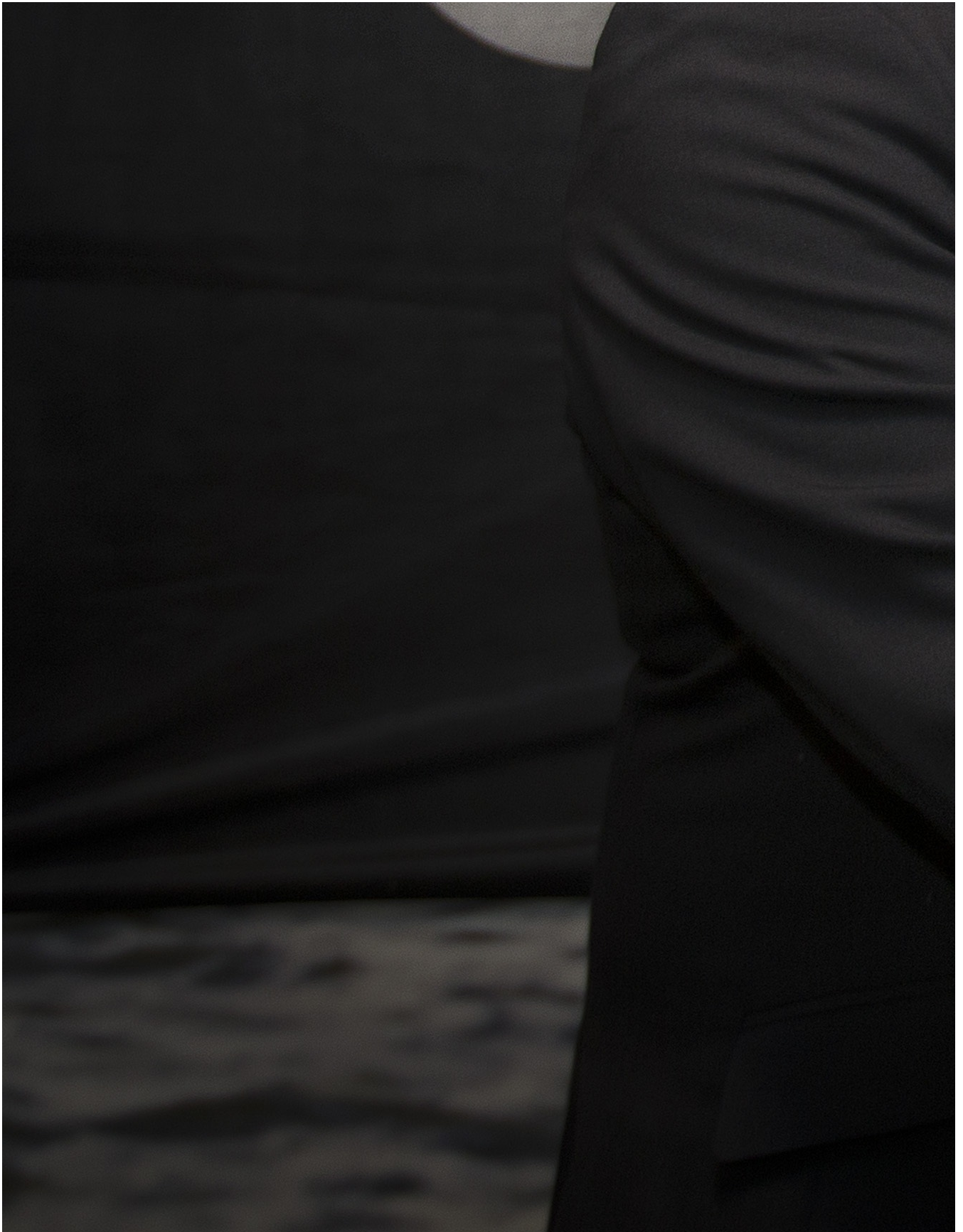


Lockheed Martin Announced As An Official Supporter Of The Invictus Games The Hague 2020
