In April, the MDA awarded Lockheed Martin a \$180.3 million contract to produce additional interceptors and oneshot devices. The award marked the 15th lot of THAAD interceptors on order for the U.S. government and was a modification to the previous contract.

THAAD's flight test success rate and combat-proven status continues to drive demand and demonstrates our global commitment to 21st Century Security. The THAAD Weapon System has a 100% flight test intercept record and in 2022, successfully demonstrated integration with the PAC-3 MSE interceptor.
